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Quick Reference

Before you begin:

Make sure your printer manufacturer drivers are installed and that your printer is connected and running properly. Print a test page.

Note* - a full user guide is located in the AccuRIP Program Folder for trial users and program owners. Tech support data is also available online.

First-time Install Setup Wizard - and - Upgrades

● First time installers/users will see the Installer WIZARD:

Install and launch AccuRIP. Properly enter your serial number (see below). Upon first launch the AccuRIP Setup Wizard will appear and walk you through the setup and creation of your AccuRIP print driver - fast and easy! After the Wizard is complete you can "fine tune" your results using the Setup Options located under the File Menu within the AccuRIP software.

● Trial version upgrades, previous installs and updates:

Trial users: Unlock AccuRIP from the trial mode by entering a serial number. The "Enter Serial Number" option is located under the "Purchase Menu" in AccuRIP.

Updates and Upgrades: Download the latest software FREE from www.accurip.net and use the latest trial version to update your serialized (purchased) software. There is no need to re-enter the serial number.



Windows Vista Users

Some Windows Vista users may encounter an error when AccuRIP attempts to build a print driver due to the new Windows UAC (user account control) security feature. Refer to Special Instruction on pg 4.



Entering the Serial Number Properly

The AccuRIP serial number begins with "ACCURIP.."
Example code: **ACCURIP- 6XL0-N70G-D4KL-TWJ8-xxxx**
Codes never contain the letter "O", only the number "ZERO".
Enter "hyphens" (-) between groups.

Setup without the Wizard

Launch AccuRIP. If the Wizard appears select Quit/Cancel. From the File Menu choose SETUP. Within the 3 sections (Tabs) answer the questions. At completion a print driver is built. See the following pages for more details.



Windows users:

If you receive an Error Code during setup refer to the Special Instruction on pg 4.



Windows Setup without Wizard

AccuRIP supports Windows XP and Vista (32 and 64 bit ready).

1. Run the AccuRIP installer.
2. Once the installation is complete, if AccuRIP does not “auto launch” then click the Windows Start Menu, go to Programs, locate and launch AccuRIP.
3. From the File Menu in AccuRIP choose “Setup.”
4. Setup is divided into 3 easy sections. Address all options. Depending on your screen size it may be necessary to scroll to see all options you can enlarge the window.

Click the options that work best for you then click OK.

If you receive an Error Code during setup refer to the Special Instruction on pg 4.

5. After AccuRIP informs you that a driver has been successfully added to the system, from the File Menu choose “Test Print.”
6. When you have successfully printed a “Test” and you are satisfied with the print result (density and clarity) you can begin using AccuRIP to make film positives.
7. Simply choose the AccuRIP to Printer (model)” driver from your printer in the pop-down list of printers in any application/program you wish to print from (i.e. AccuRIP to Epson 1400 - or AccuRIP to EcoPro).

Detailed Feature Explanations in User Guide

Detailed information for all settings can be found in the user guide located on the installer CD or in the AccuRIP Program Folder/Application Folder on your computer.



Mac Setup without Wizard

AccuRIP supports Mac OS 10.4.5 (Tiger) or higher (Leopard).

1. Run the AccuRIP installer.
2. Once the installation is complete, if AccuRIP does not “auto launch” then go to the Systems Main Application folder, locate and launch AccuRIP.
3. From the File Menu in AccuRIP choose “Setup.”
4. Setup is divided into 3 easy sections. Address all options. Depending on your screen size it may be necessary to scroll to see all options you can enlarge the window.

Click the options that work best for you then click OK.

5. After AccuRIP informs you that a driver has been successfully added to the system, from the File Menu choose “Test Print.”
6. When you have successfully printed a “Test” and you are satisfied with the print result (density and clarity) you can begin using AccuRIP to make film positives.
7. Simply choose the AccuRIP to Printer (model)” driver from your printer in the pop-down list of printers in any application/program you wish to print from (i.e. AccuRIP to Epson 1400 - or AccuRIP to EcoPro).




Error Code 5:

When configuring AccuRIP through the Wizard or through the Setup option and an Error Code 5 is encountered:

1. Quit AccuRIP
2. From the Windows Start Menu locate and open the AccuRIP program folder. "Right Click" on the AccuRIP program icon and choose "Run as Administrator"
3. Choose "Allow." AccuRIP will now launch.
4. Setup your driver from the WIZARD or the SETUP option (File Menu/Setup).

Error Code 2:

When configuring AccuRIP through the Wizard or through the Setup option and an Error Code 2 is encountered:

1. From the Start Menu/Control Panel/Printer Setup choose "Add Printer."
2. Choose Local Printer
3. When asked to choose a PORT choose "AccuRIP Port (Standard TCP/IP Port)". **YES it is TCP!!**
4. When asked for a driver choose "have disk."
5. When asked to select the disk choose "Browse."  - or without the x86
6. Navigate to the program at the default location C:Drive/Programs Files x86/Fawkes Engineering/AccuRIP (installer default location) or at your custom installed location.
7. Within the AccuRIP folder locate and select the file called "accurip.inf". Choose OPEN.
8. Once back to the "Browse Window" - Click OK
- * 9. Select the proper printer from a list of printers and complete the setup process by clicking Next. **When asked to print a test page DO NOT PRINT.**
10. **If prompted for Windows certificaton of driver choose "Install anyway!"**
11. **MOST IMPORTANT STEP!!** Launch and from the FILE MENU choose SETUP and set the resolutions and halftones as needed - or if Setup Wizard reappears use the Wizard to configure.
