1) Polyester printing

- Bleed: discuss how to check fabric for bleed, and discuss the how, why, and whats of bleeding
- Demo what happens when you print on polyester with cotton white vs. low-bleed white; Force fabric to bleed - show what not to do and how fabric still can bleed when too much heat is applied
- Demo low-cure ink to prevent bleeding
- Discuss what ghosting is and how to prevent it

2) Nylon

- Print demo using 901 series and catalyst. Discuss how to mix properly and prevent the catalyst from hardening.
- Discuss difference between chemical adhesion bond vs. mechanical bond
- Discuss how to pre-treat water-repellent nylon shells or rainwear

3) Athletic

- How to print on athletic mesh fabrics: what to look out for, what mesh counts would be best, how not to get too much ink on the mesh to prevent holes from being covered
